of the Within Writ to me directed to the Justices within Mentioned I Certifie that I have attached as the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of the Within Named Thomas Maddocks to the Value of four pounds, fourteen Shillings and money and five hundred pounds of t^o. in the hands of Joseph M^{re} Carter and I further Certifie that I have given Notice unto the said Joseph M^{re} Carter that he be and appear before the Justices within Mentioned at the time and place within Contained to show Cause if any he have why the same should not be paid in his hands towards Satisfying unto the Within Named Benjamin Cottman his Damages and Costs within Contained before John Doe & Richard Roe good and Lawfull Men of my Bedwich as by the within writ I am Commanded so answer - (Ch. Ballard Clerke)

Whereupon the afo^d Joseph Maulester Garnishee of the afo^d Thomas Maddocks appears in his own proper person and say^s that he cannot pay any but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the said Thomas Maddocks to the Value of One pound twelve Shillings and four pence; nor but that the same ought to be paid in his hands for the Use of the said Benjamin Cottman as of the Rights and Credits of the said Thomas Maddocks which the said Jst does not pay any

Whereupon the said Benjamin Cottman by his Attorney afo^d pray^s that upon giving Security amounting to act of assembly the Sum of 100^l as afo^d Confessed, by the afo^d Joseph M^{re} Carter as of the Rights and Credits of the said Thomas Maddocks may be paid in the hands of the said Joseph M^{re} Carter towards Satisfying unto the said Benjamin Cottman as well the Sum of four pounds, fourteen Shillings and money and five hundred pounds of t^o as also the Costs accruing upon this Writ of Attachment afo^d - Thereupon George Dashiell of South County Gauch present here in Court undertakes for the said Benjamin Cottman according to act of assembly that in Case the said Thomas Maddocks do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the Claim of the said Benjamin Cottman against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the Issuing of this Attachment that then the said Benjamin Cottman shall make restitution to him the said Thomas Maddocks of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said George Dashiell will do it for him -

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the Eighteenth day of June A^d 1723. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three afo^d that the said Sum of One pound twelve Shillings and four pence part of the Sum so attached and Confessed be paid in the hands of the said Joseph Maulester as of the Rights and Credits of the said Thomas Maddocks towards Satisfying unto the said Benjamin Cottman as well the Sum of ^{fourteen Shillings} four pounds and five hundred pounds of t^o. and also the Costs accruing upon the writ of Attachment afo^d and that the said Benjamin Cottman have his Execution there of against the said Jst Maulester according to act of assembly -

Mean^{ing} the Garnishee Jst Maulester voluntarily takes his Oath that he hath no more of the Effects of the Deft^r within his hands than what he has Confessed
