Errors Excepted of James Lindow

November 22: 1722 then came Capt James Lindow and took his Oath on the holy Evangelist of almighty God  
 that the above said is just and true and that he never received any part thereof

And the aforesaid William Summers by William Sawwell his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when  
 Court and prays Leave to Imparle here unto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to  
 the Court also - At which said next Court to wit Eighteenth day of June Aund Dowd One thousand and  
 Seven hundred and twenty three comes against as well the said James Lindow by his attorney aforesaid as the said  
 William Summers by his attorney aforesaid and the same William Sawwell attorney for the said William Summers  
 says that he is not informed of any answer for benefit of the same debt, to the aforesaid Court in the year aforesaid  
 to be given and nothing else thereof says by that the same gift remains against the aforesaid debt those of undepended  
 of that the aforesaid Court his damages by reason of the premises aforesaid he ought to recover - Whereupon the  
 Justice here at the prayer of the same gift do aforesaid the damages of the same Court by reason of the  
 premises aforesaid besides his costs and Charges by him about his Suite in that part sustained to two pounds Seven  
 Shillings and One penny Court money

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here Eighteenth day of  
 June Aund Dowd: One thousand and Seven hundred and twenty three aforesaid that the said James Lindow recover
