And whereupon the said Richard by Francis Allen his attorney Complaineth that whereas the aforesaid John the twenty second day of September in the Year of Our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and fifteen at the aforesaid County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indicted unto the aforesaid Richard in the Summe of twenty five pounds Six Shillings and two pence being as well for work done by the said Richard for the aforesaid John as also for divers goods wares and merchandizes by the same Richard unto the aforesaid John at the Special Instance and request of the same John Before that time there sold and delivered as by an account thereof in Court ready to be produced may appear and so there of being indicted the aforesaid John afterwards to with the same two and twentieth day of September in the Year aforesaid at the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction aforesaid in Consideration thereof upon himself did assume and unto the aforesaid Richard then and there faithfully did promise that he the aforesaid John the same twenty five pounds Six Shillings and two pence unto the same Richard when thereof afterwards he should be required well and faithfully would pay and Content Nevertheless the aforesaid John his promise and assumption so as it is said made nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending this said Richard in this part craftily and Subtly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid twenty five pounds Six Shillings and two pence or any part thereof unto the same Richard hath not paid or in any sort Contented altho' to doe the same the aforesaid John afterwards to with the first day of August in the Year of Our Lord God Seven hundred and twenty two at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid by the aforesaid Richard he was required but that unto him hitherto to pay or in any sort to Content altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the said Richard of fifty pounds Money aforesaid and thereupon he Bringeth Suite &c.
