Now hereat this day to wit the twentieth day of August anno domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three appears here in Court the ſaid Alice Ellis and praye that her appearance may be deferred to ſave her ſecurity from the above Recognoitance of Baile entered into as aſt herenpon the ſaid Alice Ellis appearance is deferred and her ſecurity is and discharged therefrom — Whereupon it Ordered by the Court here that the ſaid Merrick Ellis and Alice his wife give New Recognoitance for their appearance at next November Court to give Evidence on Behalfe of the Lord Proprietary againſt Mary Cavanagh Sarah Walker ſen<sup>d</sup>.
