Thereupon William Sloughton of Som<sup>ers</sup> set<sup>ts</sup> County Esq<sup>r</sup>. present here in Court undertakes for the said Anne Shiles and Eliz<sup>th</sup> Sturt And acknowledged himself to owe and stand Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietaries in the Sum of forty pounds Court money for the use of the said Lord Proprietaries his heirs and Successors to be devised on his Body goods or Chattel Lands or tenements &c In case the said Anne Shiles and Eliz<sup>th</sup> Sturt do not make their personal appearance Before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek for Som<sup>ers</sup> set<sup>ts</sup> County of the third Tuesday of this Instant November next and then and there give such Evidence as they shall know against Mary Cavanaugh Sarah Walker Sen<sup>r</sup>. Sarah Walker Jun<sup>r</sup>. Susannah Walker and Mary Walker of and Concerning their feloniously Stealing Certain Cloaths the goods of Merrick Ellis and John Banister and do not depart the same Court without Leave
