Sarah Stevens to read well in the Bible and to Knitt Sew and Spin and Other housewifery, and to find and provide
for her Sufficient meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing mete for her to have and ware during her Servitude &c.

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the Said Lazarus Madding give Security for the Performance of the
Covenants afoe. Thereupon the Said Lazarus Madding with John Broughton his Surety present here in Court
acknowledged themselves to Owe and Stand Justly Indebted unjoyntly and severally unto the Said Sarah Stevens,
her Heirs and affigures in the Summe of thirty pounds Court money to be Levied on their Body goods and Chattels -
Land, or tenements for the use of the Said Sarah Stevens, In case the Said Lazarus Madding do not Learn the
Said Sarah Stevens to read well in the Bible, and to Knitt Sew and Spin during her Servitude afoe and Likewise
to find and Provide for her Sufficient meat drink washing Lodging and apparel afoe &c

Joseph Dashell - Nowhereat this day to witt the twentieth day of August and anno One thousand Seven hundred
and twenty three comes here into Court a certain Joseph Dashell of Somerset County son in
law of Capt Joseph Manchester and prays that he may have the liberty of choosing a certain George Collier
as his guardian he being arrived to full years according to Law &c which is granted him &c. Whereupon
the Said Joseph Dashell makes choice of the Said George Collier as his guardian &c. Whereupon the afoe Joseph
Manchester present here in Court is Ordered to deliver up unto the Said George Collier guardian of the afoe
Joseph Dashell all that part of the Said Joseph Dashell Estate that doth Justly Belong to him Out of
his Estate fathers Estate, that he hath in his hand &c. Whereupon it is further Ordered by the Court that the Said
George Collier give good Security for the same keeping of the Said Joseph Dashell Estate that shall be delivered
unto him by the Said Joseph Manchester, and Likewise to return the same to the Said Joseph Dashell when he
shall arrive to full years according to Law to receive the same

Whereupon the Said George Collier together with Robert Collier his Security present here in Court acknowledg-
edged themselves to Owe and Stand Justly Indebted unjoyntly and severally unto the Said Joseph Dashell his
Heirs and affigures in the full and Just sume of One hundred pounds Court money to be Levied on their Body goods
or Chattels Lands or tenements for the use of the Said Joseph Dashell his Heirs and affigures In case the Said
George Collier doe not Preserve and Securely Keep all that Part of the Said Joseph Dashell Estate that shall
be delivered to him by the Said Joseph Manchester, and Likewise to deliver the same unto the Said Joseph Dashell
when he shall arrive to full years according to Law to receive the same and Comply with the Law in that respect
Relating to guardians &c Then the above recognizance to be void &c
