UPON the motion of M^r. Francis Allen on behalf of a certain Cornelius Morris afore said Person, against a certain Somerset Dickenson who Inter-married with the daughter of the said Cornelius - &c. But since the deliver of the Stock household stuff and Other Substance of the said Cornelius unto the said Somerset, he the said Somerset hath not Complied with his agreement: as on his part ought to be performed as by the said Cornelius appears here in Court &c.

Whereupon the Court having heard their severall allegations as well on the part of the said Cornelius as on the part of the said Somerset and having naturally weighed and Considered the same It's Ordered by the Court that the said Cornelius Morris take issue with the said Somerset Dickenson and that the said Somerset Dickenson Comply for the future with the agreement upon pain and penalty that shall fall thereon &c.

Upon the motion of Thomas Hayward Esq. of Somerset County Court for the Building a house on the publick Land at Somerset County Court house at Dividing Creek for his Office. Granted according to the motion of &c.

Thomas Hayward Esq. of Somerset County Offers William Taylor as his deputy to this Court who is approved of and took the solemn Oath appointed by act of assembly and Subscribed the Oath of abjuration &c.

upon the motion of M^r. Alexander Stale Esq. of Somerset County Court for the amendment of a certain record that he had made against a certain Thomas Carry of Somerset County, that whereas the said Thomas Carry was fined five thousand pounds of tobacco for the Breach of a general Law of this Province, and the said Alexander Stale in offering and making upon of the same record Entered the fine five hundred pound of tobacco and the same in figures &c. hereupon it's Ordered by the Court that the said Alexander Stale have the Liberty to amend the same record &c.
