All which said ~~not~~ second Tuesday of and twelvth day of March and Dated One thousand Seven hundred and twenty two being the day of the return of the writ afft Comell the said Thomas Howell by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of Dorchester County to whom the same writ was directed Likewise Comell and marked return hereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words vizt Non Est Inventus p

Whereupon the said Thomas Howell by his attorney afft prays that forasmuch as he hath transgressed with the Law & he may have judgment against the said William Kenney for his damages afft and for his costs and charges accruing thereupon by way of attachment, and for that it seemeth to the Court here that the said Thomas Howell hath transgressed with the Law as alledged -

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the same day and year last mentioned that the said Thomas Howell recover against the said William Kenney as well the sume of eight thousand pounds of tobacco his damages by reason of the premises afft as also all Costs and Charges by the said offfth laid Out and Expended about his suit by way of attachment against the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said William Kenney according to act of assembly in that case made and provided & - In testimony whereof I have hereunto

Whilbeing read and heard the said Thomas Howell by his attorney afft prays that he may have an attachment out of this Court for his damages in the Judgment afft mentioned as also for his Costs and Charges accruing thereupon as also for his Costs and Charges in this Court for the obtaining the same attachment against the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said William Kenney according to act of assembly &c - whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen, heard and fully understood and mature deliberation whereupon had - It is therefore considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August and Dated One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the said Thomas Howell have attachment against the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said William Kenney according to act of assembly, on the Judgment afft, for as well the sume of eight thousand pounds of tobacco certain damages afft mentioned, as also for his Costs and Charges already (arreaging)
