Thomas Howelle } memorandum the 15th died out his Lordships writt of attachment against the debts the tenor
of which followeth in these words viz: Dorchester County s: Charles absolute Lord and -
Wm Kenneys farmkeeper } Proprietarie of the Colonies of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c to the Sheriff

Dorchester County greeting wee Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels rights or Credits of William Kenney
if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of Eight thousand pounds of tobacco and when you have the same
attached or any part thereof of the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have ~~that~~ be fore the Justices of our Court
to be held at the town of Cambridge the Second Tuesday of June next then and there to be Condemned according to act
of assembly to and for the use of Peter lami Thomas Howelle unless the said William Kenney by himselfe or his attorney shall
appear and answer unto the said Thomas Howelle in a plea of tria facta upon the Case according to Law and that by good
and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same
attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our said Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any
he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be
condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in that Case made and provid:
ed if to him her or them it shall seem meett and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our said
Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writt Witness Jacob Looberman Esq: Chief Justice
of our said Court the Sixteenth day of March in the Eighth year of our Dominion &c Anno s: Dom: 1723

At which said Second Tuesday of June to wit the Eleventh day of the same Month and Year One thousand seven
hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writt Cometh the Thomas Howelle by Francis Allen his
attorney and the Sheriff of Dorchester County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise Cometh and make the return
thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following viz: To the worshipfull Justices within Mentioned I humbly
Certifie that by virtue of the Within Writt to me directed I have attached in the hands of William Smalls five Sheep of
the value of five hundred pounds of tobacco, in the hands of Charles Smith Nine hundred pounds of tobacco, in the hands of
John Adams ten Shillings, and ten Bushells of Indian Corn of the value of three hundred twenty pounds of tobacco in
the hands of Thomas Thomas, five hundred pounds of tobacco in the hands of Sarah Sticks five hundred pounds of
tobacco and in the hands of Thomas Howelle One pound Eleven Shillings of the value of three hundred and seventy
two pounds of tobacco, and further that I have made known unto the severall persons in whose hands I have made the
same attachments that they be and appear at the time and place within Contained to shew Cause &c before John Luterhan
and John Doe good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick as by the within writt I am Comanded so as followeth.
