Memorandum the 8th by Lewis Gale his attorney sued out his Lordships writt of attachment against the deft the tenor whereof is as followeth Vizt. - Sommersett County s^r. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietarie of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff of Sommersett County greeting Wee Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Anthony Moore of Roseby Parish in Sommersett County planter ad: dicit. Anthony Moore of Sommersett County planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe Keep so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Sommersett County apt the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to Act of assembly to and for the Use of a certain Thomas Dashiell unless the said Anthony Moore by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Thomas Dashiell in a plea that he tender unto him full and Just summe of two thousand One hundred Ninty two pounds of tobacco which to him he Owes and unjustly detains &c according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the Person or persons in whose hands you made the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our said Court to be held as apt to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the form of the act of assembly in that Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seeme mete and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the same day and Place apt and have you there and there this writt Witness Charles Ballard Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the Twentieth day of June in the Eighth Year of our Dominion &c and Done 1723 - (L Gale) Thomas Hayward
