The deft the tenor whereof is as followeth vizt. — Somerset County for Charles absolute Lord and Proprietarie of the provinces of maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting We command you that you attack any the good Chattle, Rights or Credits of —

Anthony More of Rosebury Parish in Somerset County planter ad: dñe. Anthony More of Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your Bailewick to the value of two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attacked or any part thereof the same in your custody keep it so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County on the third Tuesday of August next there

and there to be condemned according to Statute of Assembly to aid for the use of a certain Thomas Dashell unless the said Anthony More by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Thomas Dashell in agree that he render unto him full and just sume of two thousand One hundred Ninety two pounds of tobacco which to him he owes and unjustly detains according to Law and that by good and lawfull means of your Bailewick you make it known unto the Person or persons in whose hands you made the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our

Said Court to be held as afo' to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods chattle, Rights or Credits so attacked in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the form of the act of assembly in that case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seeme meet and how you — shall execute this writt that you make it known unto our Said Justices at the same day and place afo' and have you there and there his writt witness Charles Ballard Gentle Chief Justice of our Said Court the Eleventh day of June in the Eighth year of Our Dominion & anno Domini 1723 — (I Hale) Thomas Hayward (T)
