memorandum the gift by George Dashiell his attorney sued out his Lordships writ of attachment against the defend<sup>t</sup> the tenor whereof followeth in these words viz. Somerset County for Charles absolute Lord and proprietor of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher<sup>iff</sup> of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach any the goods Chattles Rights or Credits of Robert Berry late of Allhollows Parish in the County of Somerset planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached on any part thereof the same in your Custody safe Keep so that you have the same before the Justices of Our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County on the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the Use of a certain Thomas Dashiell unless the said Robert Berry by himself or his attorney appear and answer unto the said Thomas Dashiell in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of Our said Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattles Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in that Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto the Justices of Our said Court at the same day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writt Witness - Charles Ballard Gent<sup>l</sup>: Chief Justice of Our said Court the nineteenth day of June in the Eighth year of Our Dominion &c. and Date 1723 - - - (J.
