At which said third Tuesday of August towitt the twenty-third day of the same month and anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three Being the day of the return of the said Writt Comitt the said Thomas Dashell by his attorney asd and the Sheriff of Sommersett County to whom the foregoing Writt was directed Likewise Comitt and made the return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these wads following d^rg - By virtue of the within Writt to me directed to the Justices within Mentioned I Certifie that I have attached as the goods and Chattels lights or Creditts of the Within Named Robert Gerry, to the value of two hundred and fifty pounds, of tobacco in the hands of John Tull, and five hundred pounds of tobacco in the hands of Samuel Bratton, and I further Certifie that I have given Notice unto the said George John Tull and Samuel Bratton that they be and appear before the Justices within Mentioned at the time and place within Convene to shew cause if any they have why the same Should not be Condemned in their hands towards Satisfying of the within Named Thomas Dashell his damages and Costs within Convene before Matthew Hopkins and John Doe good and Lawfull men of my Balswick as by the within Writt I am Commanded so affers Ias: McCarter Sheriff

Whereupon the afo John Tull Garnishee of the afo Robert Gerry appears in his own proper person and says that he cannot garnishe but that he hath of the Rights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry to the value of two hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco nor but the same Ought to be Condemned in his hand, for the use of the said Thomas Dashell as of the lights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry whil the said offt doth not garnishe —

Likewise the said Samuel Bratton Garnishee of the afo Robert Gerry appears in his own proper person and says that he cannot garnishe but that he hath of the lights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry to the value of two hundred pence to be paid in Country Product, nor but that the same Ought to be Condemned in his hand, for the use of the said Thomas Dashell as of the lights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry whil the said offt doth not garnishe —

Whereupon the said Thomas Dashell by his attorney asd pray the sumes asd so asd Confessd by the afo John Tull and Samuel Bratton as of the lights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry may be Condemned in the hand of the said John Tull, and Samuel Bratton towards Satisfying unto the said Thomas Dashell as well the sume of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco as alfo accruing upon the writ of attachment —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the twenty-third day of August and anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three that the said sume of two hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco so asd attached and Confessd be Condemned in the hand of the said John Tull as of the lights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry towards Satisfying unto the said Thomas Dashell as well the sume of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco as also the costs accruing upon the writ of attachment asd and that the said Thomas Dashell have his Execution there of against the said John Tull according to act of assembly —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the same day and year last mentioned that the said sume of two hundred pence to be paid in Country product as afo Confessd be Condemned in the hands of the said Samuel Bratton as of the lights and Creditts of the Said Robert Gerry toward Satisfying unto the said Thomas Dashell as well the sume of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco asd
