Case made and provided if to this her or them it shall seem need and how you shall execute this writt that you —  
make known unto our Said Justice at the day and place &c and have you there and there this Writt witness'd Charles  
Ballard Gentleman Justice of our Said Court the intended day of June in the Eighth Year of Our Domini in

All which said third Tuesday of August to will the twenty third day of the same month and year One thousand  
Seven hundred and twenty three being the day of the return of the said Writ comes the said Margarett Lady Ball-  
imore Esq as aforesaid by her attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somersett County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed  
likewise comes and makes return hereof underst in these words following to w<sup>r</sup>t. By virtue of the within Writ so  
directed to the Justice within mentioned I Certifie that I have attached as the goods Challes lights & Credits  
of the Willm Named James Trail Son and heire of Willm Trail late of Somersett County dec'd fifteen hundred  
pounds of tobacco in the hands of Willm Lane of Somersett County to satisfy unto the within named Marg<sup>r</sup> —  
Lady Ballimore Esq as within contained her debt and Costs recovered against the said James Trail Son & heire  
as aforesaid and further Certifie that I have given Notice to the said Willm Lane that he be and appear at the  
time and place within contained to New Cause if any he have why the same should not be condemned in his  
hands for the use of the said Margarett Lady Ballimore &c before Mathew Haycock and John Doe good  
and Lawfull men of my Baileynish as by the within Writ I am commanded to answer for the afforementioned  
Whereupon the said Willm Lane <sup>Plaintiffe of the aforesaid James Trail Son & heire aforesaid</sup> Solemnly called to New Cause why &c Consider not but makes  
default nor does any other person appear for him to New Cause to the contrary &c —

Whereupon the said Margarett Lady Ballimore Esq as aforesaid by her attorney aforesaid prayeth that the  
aforesaid sum of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco so aforesaid attached in the hands of the aforesaid Willm Lane  
as of the lights and Credits of the said James Trail Son and heire aforesaid may be condemned in the  
hands of the said Willm Lane toward satisfying unto the said Margarett Lady Ballimore Esq  
as aforesaid as well his Debt and Costs against him recovered as also Costs upon this writt of attachment —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the twenty third day of August anno domini One  
thousand Seven hundred and twenty three aforesaid that the said sum of fifteen hundred pounds of tobacco  
so aforesaid attached be condemned in the hands of the said Willm Lane as of the lights and Credits  
of the said James Trail Son and heire of the aforesaid Willm Trail &c toward satisfying unto the  
said Margarett Lady Ballimore Esq as aforesaid as well the Debt & Costs recovered against him as all  
Costs ensuing upon the writt of attachment aforesaid and that the said Marg<sup>r</sup> Lady Ballimore Esq as  
aforesaid have thereof Execution against the said Willm Lane according to act of Assembly &c
