

Lt. Thomas Daskell } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Robert
 Robert Boyer } Boyer late of Rowley Parish in the County of Gloucestre if he should be found in his
 Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices
 of the County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of August
 then next to answer unto Thomas Daskell of Aglea of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thereof he should
 not fail &c. - and the said Thomas Daskell by Lewi Gale his attorney declared against the
 said Robert Boyer in the plea of assumpsit viz. Somerset County. Robert Boyer late
 of Rowley Parish in the County of Gloucestre was attached to answer unto Thomas Daskell of Aglea
 of trespass upon the Case &c. And whereupon the said Thomas by Lewi Gale his attorney complains
 that whereas the said Robert the twentieth day of May One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three at the
 parish of Wills in the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Thomas the sum of five hundred
 and seventy four pounds of tobacco for Sheriff dues Lewis &c. and for bearing thereupon as by ans.
 therewith in Court produced may more fully appear and so thereof being indebted the said Robert
 in consideration thereof afterwards viz. the day and year aforesaid at the place aforesaid within the aforesaid
 Jurisdiction upon himself assumed and to the said Thomas then and there faithfully promised that
 he when afterwards he should be thereto requested the aforesaid sum of five hundred and seventy four
 pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas would well and faithfully content and pay Never the less the
 said Robert his promise and assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made little regarding but plotting and
 fraudulently intending the said Thomas in that part to defraud and deceive the aforesaid sum of five hundred
 and seventy four pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas (albeit the said Robert was thereto
 requested the twentieth day of June One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three hath not paid nor
 him for it in any wise contented but the said Robert, the same to Thomas hath to pay or him
 for it in any wise to content hath altogether refused and still doth refuse whereby the said Thomas
 says he is the worse and hath damage to the value of Eleven hundred forty eight pounds of tobacco
 and thereof brings this Suit &c. Lewi Gale of Quert. Esq. & Esq. & Esq. &c. &c.
