

Dashill by his attorney afo and the Sher^d of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed did with a Council and make the return thereof to the Court here Entered in these words following vizt Legi^o Corpus pro me Joseph Maulster Sher^d

Whereupon the said Robert Boyer appears and at the prayer of the p^lts attorney the said Robert Boyer is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action afo. Thereupon certain James Ward of Somerset County Esquire present here in Court undertakes for the said Robert Boyer that in case the said Thomas Dashill shall recover Judgment in the plea afo against the said Robert Boyer, or that the said Robert Boyer shall be therein Convicted that then he the said Robert Boyer shall pay the Condemnation of the Court hereupon or tender his Body to the Custody of the Sher^d of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said James Ward will do it for him

Whereupon the said Robert Boyer in his own proper person comes and defends the face and shewing when c^d and says that he cannot gain say the p^lts his action afo so as afo against him Brought nor can he say but that the said Legi^o Brought to recover his damages by Quassion of the premises afo to the sume of five hundred and seventy four pounds of tobacco and Costs of suite against him which the said p^lts doth not gain say c^d

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August und^{er} Seal One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three afo that the said Thomas Dashill recover against the said Robert Boyer as well the sume of five hundred and seventy four pounds of tobacco Certain damages afo in full afo Confesed as also the sume of Two hundred & Ninety four --- --- pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in this Behalfe said Out and Expended and had afo in m^{er}cy c^d

Command was given to the Sher^d of Somerset County that he should take John Bredy of Stegney Parish administrator of all and singular the goods and Chattels of James Bredy ad^ud. James Bredy Bredy late of the said Parish dec^d. if he should be found in his Parish and him should safe Keep so that he might have his Body Before the Justices of ^{his Lordships} County Court to be held at Dwiding Creek in Somerset County afo the third Tuesday of August then next to answer unto Thomas Dashill of plea of tres pass upon the Case and that there of he should not fail c^d

And the said Thomas Dashill by George Dashill his attorney declares against the said John Bredy ad^ud. as afo in the plea afo as followeth vizt. - Somerset County s^d. John Bredy of Stegney Parish ad^ud. of all and singular the goods and Chattels of James Bredy late of the said Parish dec^d was attached to answer unto Thomas Dashill of plea of tres pass upon the Case c^d. - And whereupon the said Thomas Dashill s^d. George Dashill his attorney Complains that whereas the said James in the Year of Our Lord had One thousand seven hundred and Eighteen at Stegney Parish in the County afo within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Thomas in the sume of four hundred and seventy pounds of tobacco as p^{ro}nom^o here unto annexed may in Court appear and being indebted as afo for and in Consideration afo at the time and place afo did upon him self a promise and to the said Thomas then and there did faith fully promise that the sume of four hundred and seventy pounds of tobacco he would pay and Content when he should be there unto requested Never the less the said James in his Life time the sume afo did not pay nor the said John in his Legality since his decease altho' often
