Bailewiche as by the within Writ I am Commanded so Answere - Joseph Mæſterle Sheriſſ

Whereupon the Said John Pees by his attorney aſt pray that the Said Edward Cuffe to his witt of Sureties
aſt may answer But the Said Edward Cuffe altho' Solemly Called Cometh not nor sheweth cause why he but makes
default whereby the Said aſt remains against the Said debt thereof undefeended &

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August anno Domini One thousand
Seven hundred and twenty three aſt that the Said John Pees have his Execution against the Said Edward Cuffe
for as well the sume of five pounds Thirteen Shillings and Seven pence Court money of America his debt aſt as also the
sume of two hundred and Sixty Nine pounds aſt to be Costs of Suite in the Judgment aſt Specified as also the sume of
