of the Judgmt: afo against him the said Edward Cuffe according to the form of the law very of he ought not to have  
if to him it shall seem mete and have you then and there the Names of those by whom you make the same known  
and this writt Witness Charles Ballard Justice of Our said Court the Nineteenth day of June in the  
Eighth year of Our Dominion &c and Dated 1723 -- (J. Allen) Thomas Hayward Esq.

At which said third Tuesday of August to witt the twentieth day of the same month anni Domini One thousand  
Seven hundred and twenty three Being the day of the return of the said Writt Cometh the said John Pees by  
his attorney afo and the Sherif: of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writt was directed Likewise Cometh  
make the return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following viz By virtue of the within Writt to  
me directed to the Justices within Mentioned I Certifie that I have made known unto the Writth named Edward  
Cuffe that he be and appear before the Justices within Mentioned at the time and place within Contained to shew  
Cause if any he hath or knoweth to say why the within Named John Pees should not have his Execution agt:  
him for the debt and Costs within Contained before Hugh Carter and John Doe good and Lawfull men of my  
Bailiwick as by the within Writt Jam Comanded so answer - Joseph MacCarter Sherif

Whereupon the said John Pees by his attorney afo pray that the said Edward Cuffe to his writt of Sureties  
afo may answer But the said Edward Cuffe altho solemnly Called Comes not nor shew Cause why he but makes  
default whereby the said pft remains against the said deft thereof undefended &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the twentieth day of August anni Domini One thousand  
Seven hundred and twenty three afo that the said John Pees have his Execution against the said Edward Cuffe  
for as well the sume of five pounds thirteene Shillings and seven pence Court money of America his Debt afo as also the  
sume of two hundred and sixty nine pounds of Tobacco Costs of Suite in the Judgmt: afo specified as also the sume of  
Two hundred & Twenty six pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged in to him for  
his Costs and Damages Sustained by Quareon of Delay of Execution of the Judgmt: afo &c
