Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the Nineteenth day of March And now one thousand Seven hundred and twenty two that the said Richard Tiler recover against the said Joseph Compton as well the sum of One pound Sixteen Shillings and nine Pence Curr. money of Maryland his damages by Occasion of the Commission aforesaid as also the sum of Two hundred and forty pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in this behalf Said Out and Expended and the Defect in money &c

Christopher Glass - Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take Henry Bishop full Sheriff
Henry Bishop - Bailiff in the County of Somerset - Elton ad. dictas Henry Bishop of Somerset County Elton if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to answer unto Christopher Glass of plea that he tender unto him Eight pound nine Shillings and seven Pence Curr. money of this Province which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c and that those of the Sher. not fail &c

And whereas the said Christopher Glass by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said Henry the twenty third day of January One thousand seven hundred and twenty two at a Parish and City aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certain Writing Obligatory which the said Christopher with the Seal of the said Henry signed here unto Court bearing the date whereof is the same day and year did acknowledge him self to be bound unto the said Christopher in the said Eight pound nine Shillings and seven pence to be paid unto the said Christopher when he should be therunto required yett the said Henry the often required the said Eight pound nine Shillings and seven pence to the said Christopher hath not tendered but the same hitherto to tender hath denied and still doth deny and unjustly detains to the damage of the said Christopher of sixteen pounds of money aforesaid and thereupon he brings Suite &c Allen &c. Gledje &c. J. de Koe

At which said third Tuesday of March to with the Nineteenth day of the said Month and now one thousand seven hundred and twenty two being the day of the return of the said Writ Com. the said Christopher Glass by his attorney aforesaid and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed did well come and make return thereof to the Court here Endorsed with - Copy of the said Writ Com. Elton Sher.

Whereupon the said Henry Bishop being called appears and thereupon the said Henry Bishop at the prayer of the said attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action aforesaid thereupon a Certain Thomas Robins and John Bishop Jun. of Somerset County Eltoners present here in Court undertakes for the said Henry Bishop that in Case the said Christopher Glass shall recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Henry Bishop or that the said Henry Bishop shall be therein convicted that then the said Henry Bishop shall pay the Redemption of Hunt thereupon or tender his body to the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that they the said Thomas Robins and John Bishop Jun. will do it for him

Whereupon the said Henry Bishop in his own proper Person comes and defends the plea and injury aforesaid
