Whereupon the said Nathaniel Horsey in his own proper person appears and thereupon the said Nathaniel Horsey at the prayer of the plaintiff's attorney is adjudged to give special Bail to the action aforesaid thereupon a certain Robert Ware of Somerset County planter present herein Court undertakes for the said Nathaniel Horsey that in case the said Robert Martin Sheriff Receiver Judg<sup>t</sup> against the said Nathaniel Horsey in the plea aforesaid or that the said Nathaniel Horsey shall be therein found that then he the said Nathaniel Horsey shall pay the condemnation of the Court or render his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said Robert Ware will do it for him - thereupon the said Nathaniel Horsey appears and Imparts his oath found by George Dabbert his attorney &c.

Charles absolute Lord and proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon &c. Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we command

you that you attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of William King Late of Stequoy Parish in Somerset County indebted to the value of four pounds four Shillings and Seven pence half penny and four hundred ten pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be at Dividing Creek in Somerset County aforesaid the third Tuesday of March next then and there to be found according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain George Hutchins unless the said Will
