Ordered by the Court that John Olandman pay unto M: Carters the Sum of three hundred pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance ten days as an Evidence on behalf of the said John Olandman ag: William Whittington he having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that William Whittington pay unto William Hopkins the Sum of three hundred pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance ten days as Evidence for the said William Whittington against John Olandman he having made oath to the same &c
