of Backmore &c To the Shew of Somerset County greeting Whereas Devin Denwood ad<sup>rs</sup> Dick Devin Denwood lately in our County Court here to wit, the fifteenth day of June and about one thousand seven hundred & twenty five before Samuel Hopkins Gent his associate then our Justice of our County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek, by consideration of the Same Court Recovered against Robert Hudson late of Somerset County planter ad<sup>rs</sup> Dick Robt Hudson of this County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland as well a certain debt of One hundred & Sixty pounds Curr<sup>nt</sup> money of Maryland, as also the sum of three hundred and thirty nine pounds of Curr<sup>nt</sup> money which to the same Devin in our Court were adjudged for his Costs and damages which he had by Omission the detention of the Debt and whereof he is Convict as by the record and Copies thereof in our Court before our Justice at Dividing Creek now remaining manifestly appeareth In view the Omission of the Judgment and as yett remaineth to be done The said Devin Denwood is since dead as by the Intimation of Betty Gale & Devin Gale Es<sup>rs</sup> of the testament of the said Devin Denwood we have received & because we are willing that those things which in our County Court are Rightly done should come to due Execution we Command you that by good & Lawfull men of your Body with you make known unto the said Robt Hudson that he be & appear before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to show Cause if any for himselfe he hath or knoweth to say wherefore the said Betty Gale & Devin Gale Es<sup>rs</sup> as aforesaid, their Execution against the said Robt Hudson, of the debt and damages and ought not to have
