Sum. aforesaid as also the Sum of three hundred and thirty nine pounds of tobacco. Costs of Suit in the Judgment aforesaid specified as also for the Sum of three hundred and Eighteen - - - pounds of tobacco. by the Court here adjudged unto them for their Costs and Damages Sustained by Reason of Delay of Crention of the Judgment aforesaid -

And whereupon the said Ann Renshaw by Lewi Gale his attorney Complaineth that whereas the aforesaid Ann Renshaw the tenth day of June - Seven been hundred & twenty five at the County and within the the Jur. of this Court was indebted to the aforesaid Thomas in the Sum of thirteen hundred & sixty eight pounds of tobacco as by bill herewith in Court produced may appear for Troop & Officers fees And so there of being indebted unto Ann in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day & year as at the County and within the aforesaid Jur. in Consideration thereof upon herself assumed & to the said Thomas then & there faithfully promised that she when afterwards she should be there to required she the aforesaid Sum of thirteen hundred and sixty eight pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas would well & fully pay
