mentioned is yet due and unsatisfied wherefore the Said afo^d Esq^r Judgment for the debt afo^d
and his costs and Damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to him to
be adjudged -

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the fifteenth day

Waite Recover against the afo^d ^{John Summers} as well the sum of One thousand Nine
hundred and fifty four pounds of tobacco his debt afo^d as also the sum of Two hundred &
Sixty one --- pounds of tobacco for his costs and damages sustained by reason of the
