Therefore it is considered by the Justice here the ~~thirteenth~~ ^{fifteenth} day of March and ~~do~~ One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five that the ~~advs~~ Benjamin Wicks have his Execution against the ~~advs~~ Henry Williams and Alice his wife ~~advs~~ of the same Tho' Taylor for as well the Sum of Eight hundred and Eighty five pounds of tobe as also the Sum of two hundred and fifteen pounds of tobe. ~~Costs~~ as Likewise the Sum of two hundred and Sixty One pounds of tobe ~~Costs~~ in the Judgm^t ~~advs~~ specified as also the Sum of Two hundred and twenty three ~~—~~ pounds of tobe by the Court hono^red judged into him for his ~~Costs~~ and damages sustained by reason of Delay of Execution of the Judgm^t ~~advs~~ to be Levied on the goods and Chattels which were of the ~~advs~~ Thomas Taylor at the time of his death and which to the hands of of the said Henry Williams and Alice his wife ~~advs~~ as ~~advs~~ ~~the~~ should come to be administered ~~to~~

The Same memorandum the Esq by Joani Gale his attorney sued out his Writs with Ann Renshaw ~~advs~~ of Surifam against the debt the tenor of which will follow in these words to wit of Jo' Renshaw ~~—~~ Sheriff of the County of Somerset Charles absolute Lord & proprietor of the province of Maryland & avolon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. to the shire of Somerset County - greeting where as Benj^t Wicks late of Somerset County Gent lately in our County Court of Somerset here to wit, on the seveneenth day of March last and one thousand seven hundred & eighteen before the worshipful Charles Ballard and his associates then our Justice of our ^{Saids} Court & by consideration of the same Court recovered against a certain Ann Renshaw of Wreny hundred in the County of Somerset widow ~~advs~~ &c. of Jo' Renshaw late of said County dec^d. as well a certain debt of one thousand one hundred & thirty one pounds of tobe as also the sum of two hundred & fifteen pounds of tobe ~~Costs~~ ~~paid~~ & ~~paid~~ &c. whereof she is ~~convict~~ as by the records & ~~provs~~ thereof in our Court before our Justice here remaining manifestly appeareth - Nevertheless Execution of the Judgm^t as yet remaineth to be done & because we are willing that those things which in our Courts & rightly done should come to due Execution we command you that by good & lawful men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the ~~advs~~ Ann Renshaw that she be & appear before the Justice of our County Court to be held at Diving feet in Somerset County ~~advs~~ (the)
