And the said Benjamin Weller by his attorney aforesaid prayeth that the said Ann Renshaw to his due satisfaction
 may answer & pay But the said Ann Renshaw altho solemnly filed cause not but made default
 whereby the same Esq^r remains against the said John Whalley wholly undischarged &

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the said Benjamin Weller have his Execution
 against the said Ann Renshaw of the Indictment aforesaid for as well the sum of One Thousand and One Hundred
 and Ninety One pounds of tobacco paid as also the sum of two hundred and Nineteen pounds
 of tobacco paid of sum of Two hundred and Nine —

 by reason of Detention of the Indictment aforesaid to be denied of the goods and Chattels which
