 of the sd Defty Flowers at time of his Death to Peter Whitting of y^e County of Ver-
 -ginea in due form of Law was Committed as by the Letters of Administration herein
 our Court before us will appear as on the part of the sd Peter Whitting in our Court
 we have recd. and altho Judgment hereupon rendered Nevertheless Execution of the
 Damages & Costs ad to him as yett remaineth to be done to the hindrance of the Execution
 of the administration of - Whereupon the same Peter Whitting hath Supplicated us
 for a proper Remedy in that part to him to be provided & we being willing that those
 things which in our said Court are rightfully done should be duly Executed we Com-
 -mand you that by good & Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto
 the sd Tho. Layfield that he be appear before the Justices of our County Court to be held
 at Sandring Heath in Somerset County the third Tuesday of March next to hear Cause
 if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth, whereof the sd Peter Whitting
 Execution against him of the Costs ad to have ought not, according to the form of the Recovery
 ad if unto him it shall seem Expedient to shew on them & there the names of those by
 whom you make the same known & this with Wittness our Justices Gent. Chief
 Justice Bar said Court the 19th day of Novemb^r in the 10th year of our Dominion &
