And the said John Bishop by Ebenezer Cook his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c and says that he cannot gainsay the plea his action &c so as &c against him brought up for he say but that the said plea ought to recover his damages by Execution of the premises to five hundred and thirty pounds of tobe. and Costs of Suite against him which the said plea doth not gain say &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the said Joseph Mester Recover against the said Jno. Bishop as well the Sum of five hundred and thirty pounds of tobe. his damages &c in form of Confessed as also the Sum of three hundred and two pounds of tobe by the Court here ad judged unto him for his Costs and charges by him about his Suite in this behalf paid out and Expended and the said Jno. Mester in mery &c

year &c at the County &c within the said Jurisdiction thereof upon his oath & affi-  
davit &c to the same Wm. then & there faithfully promised that he when afterwards he should  
be there to request the said Sum of twenty one pounds three Shillings & five pence to the same  
Wm. he would freely & faithfully Content & pay Never the less the said Tho. his promise & affi-  
davit &c in form &c made not regarding but Blotting & fraudulently Intending the  
said Wm. in that part to defraud & deceive he the said Sum of twenty one pounds <sup>three</sup> Shillings &  
five pence or any part thereof to the same Wm. (the after ward there to requested by  
the same day & year at the County &c within the said Jurisdiction hath not paid on the same  
Wm. for it is any wise Contented but the said Thomas the same either to to pay both  
altogether refused & still doth refuse where by the same Wm. says he is wrong & hath  
Daid to the value of forty two pounds four Shillings & ten pence Sterning money & there  
of he bringeth Suite &c
