One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five came againe as well the said Archibald Govan by his attorney as the said James Robertson in his proper person, and the said James Robertson hereupon prayed further Leave to Impark hereunto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the att. also

At which said next Court to with the fifteenth day of March and Dowd. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five came againe the said Archibald Govan by his attorney and prays that the said James Robertson to his Declaration in the plea as may answer & But the same James Robertson altho' solemnly ^{called} sworn not but made default where by the att. to remaineth against the att. Doth thereof indefeasible & Wherefore the said Archibald Govan his damages
