by Occasion of the premises aforesaid against the said James Robertson ought to recover, but because it is not known what damages the said Archibald Govan sustained by Occasion of the premises aforesaid the Justices here at the prayer of the aforesaid Archibald Govan by his attorney aforesaid do assess the damages of the aforesaid Archibald Govan according to act of Assembly in such case made & provided besides his Costs and Charges to Eleven Thousand Three hundred and forty two pounds of tobacco

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the fifteenth day of March and found

One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five Pounds of Archibald Govan Recover against the aforesaid James Robertson as were the sum of Eleven Thousand Three hundred and forty two pounds of tobacco his damages by Occasion of the premises aforesaid in sum aforesaid as also the sum of Three hundred & Ninety four pounds of tobacco by the fourth here adjudged unto the same Archibald Govan for his costs and charges in his behalf Said sum and Expenses and aforesaid in money to

In Consideration thereof upon himself assumed to ydair Andrew Scott then & there faithfully promised ydair when afterwards he shold be thereto required he ydair sum of Two pounds one shill & two pence (and) mony to ydair Andrew would well & faithfully Content & pay Nevertheless ydair Giles his promise & assumption aforesaid informed and made Little regarding ydair getting & getting fraudulently Intending ydair Andrew In that art to Defraud he ydair sum of Two pounds one shill & two pence or any part thereof to ydair Andrew hath not paid or him for it in any wise Contented although ydair Samel Doe ydair Giles was afterwards thereto by ydair Andrew viz d. ydair Eleventh day of may in ydair year of County aforesaid within ydair Iur and requested but ydair Giles ydair sum to pay or ydair Andrew for it in any wise to Content hath altogether refused & still doth refuse whereby ydair Andrew say he is worse & hath Damages of value offive pounds (and) mony of small land & there of he brings this suit
