we have Received and because we are Willing, that those things which in Our said Court are
are Rightly done should be duly Executed we Command you that by good and Lawfull men
of your Bailly with you make known unto the said James Jones that he be and appear before
Our Justices of Our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek in Somerset County on the third
Tuesday of June next to shew Cause if any thing for himself he hath or knoweth to say -
wherefore the said Mary Martin Execution of the Damages and Costs of to have Ought not according
to the form of the Recovery of if to him it shall seem ~~that~~ Expedient and have you then
and there the Names of those by whom you make the Same known and this Writ Witness

that the said Mary Martin doth as yet have her Execution against the said James Jones for as well the Sum
of five hundred and ten pounds of tobacco certain Damages, as also the Sum of two hundred and ninety
of tobacco Cost of Suit, as also the Sum of two hundred and forty additional Costs of Suit in the Judgment
