One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six afd that the afd Betty Gale and Seoni Gale Esrs as afd have their Exoncion against the afd Michael Holland of the Judgm^t. afd as well for the Sum of One hundred and Sixty pounds Curr^t. money ~~for his damages~~ his Debt afd as also the Sum of four hundred and Nine pounds of tobacco Costs of Suite in the Judgm^t. afd Specified as also the Sum of three hundred and fifty Seven - - - pounds of tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto them for their Costs and Damages Sustained by Omission of Delay of Exoncion of the Judgm^t. afd be

John Dennis Sec^y. - Memorand^m " the Esch by ^{George DeLancey} ~~Jonathan Woodbury~~ his attorney Sued Out his Lordships writ of attachment against the Esch the tenor whereof followeth in these words vizt. -

Jonathan Woodbury - Somerset sh. Charles absolute Lord and proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and avolon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Shew of Somerset County greeting we command you that you, of the good, and Quittells Rights or Credits of Jonathan Woodbury late of Somerset County Mariner if they Shall be found in your Baillywick to the value of Six hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the Same attached or any part thereof the Same in your custody Safe Keep so that you have the Same Before the Justices of Our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek in Somerset County afd the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the Use of afd John Dennis Sec^y. unless the Said Jonathan Woodbury by himself or his attorney Shall appear & answer unto the Said John Dennis in open of the Court upon the fore &c. according to Law, and that by good and Lawfull men of your Baillywick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the Same attachment. that he She or they be and appear before the Justices of Our Said County Court to be hold as afd to Shew Cause if any he She or they have why the Same goods Chattells. Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hand, Ought not to be condemned and Exoncion thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it Shall Seem mete and how you Shall Execute this Writ that you make known unto

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
