Where upon the said Edward Rownd Garnishe of the said Jonathan Woodbury appears in his own proper person and says he cannot garnisay but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the said Jonathan Woodbury to the value of thirty six bushels of Indian Corn, nor but the same ought to be found in his hands for the use of the said John Dennis as of the Rights and Credits of the said Jonathan Woodbury which of said Corn does not garnisay.

Where upon the said John Dennis by his attorney of pray that upon giving Security according to act of assembly that the said Sum of thirty six bushels of Indian Corn so as is confessed by the said Edward Rownd as of the Rights and Credits of said Jonathan Woodbury may be found in the hands of the said Edward Rownd towards Satisfying unto the said John Dennis as well the Sum of Six hundred pounds of tobacco as also the costs accruing upon the writ of attachment.

Where upon after said Hugh Porter Esq. present here in Court undertakes for the said John Dennis according to act of assembly that in case the said Jonathan Woodbury do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said John Dennis Claim against him appear to be satisfied otherwise wise to have been made before the saying of this attachment. that then the said John Dennis shall make Restitution unto him the said Jonathan Woodbury of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue or that the said Hugh Porter will do it for him.
