Thomas Holbrook her husband but also to cause her innocently to be brought into danger of suff-
ring corporall punishment or forfeiting One hundred pounds of tobacco or Hhvy Rulings as
the Law in such Cases directs at the Court of the Right Honourable Charles absolute and Proprietary
