of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the  
Sherr. of Somerset County greeting We Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels rights  
or Credits of Thomas Cryor Late of Somerset County Clerk if they shall be found in your Bailly  
worth to the Value of twenty One pounds two Shillings and five pence and first money and six hundred  
red pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached on any part hereof the same in  
your Bailly safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at  
Dwinding Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be held & adjourned  
according to let of Assembly to and for the Use of a certain Writ<sup>m</sup> Emmells unless said Sh<sup>r</sup>. Cryor by  
himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said William Emmells in open Court upon  
the first day according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailly with you make known  
unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and  
appear before the Justices of our said County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any they  
have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to  
be founden and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of Assembly in  
such case made and provided if to him her or them shall seem meet and how you shall execute this  
Writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the same Day & place aforesaid and have you then  
and there this Writ Witness Samuel Hogkin Esq<sup>r</sup> Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty  
third day of August in the Eleventh Year of our said Lord &c. and one thousand seven hundred  
and twenty Six
