Whereupon the said John Phillips at this Solemnly Called to Shew Cause Comes not but makes default nor does any other person appear for him to Shew Cause to the contrary &c —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the twenty first day of June and Doth. Ennalls said Seven hundred and twenty Six that the said Sum of twenty Shillings Curr. money so as aforesaid attached may be condemned in the hands of the said John Phillips as of the Rights and Credits of the said Thomas Bryor towards Satisfying unto the said W^m Ennalls as well the Sum of twenty One pounds two Shillings and five pence Curr. money and Six hundred pounds of t^{ob}. as also the Costs accruing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid and that the said W^m Ennalls have thereof his Execution against the said John Phillips according to act of assembly

Sr. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and a Baron Lord Baron
of Baltimore &c. To the Sherif. of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach any the goods or Chattels Rights or Credits of Dudlow Beak of Somerset County Clerk if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value of twelve hundred pounds of t^{ob}. and when you have the Same attached or any part thereof the Same in your Custody safe Keep so that you have the Same before the Justice of our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the Use of aforesaid Joseph McClester unless the said Dudlow Beak by him self or his attorney Shall appear and answer unto the said Joseph McClester in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the Same attachment that he She or they be and appear before the Justice of our said County Court to be hold as aforesaid to Shew Cause if any he She or they have why the Same goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it Shall seem meet and how you Shall Execute this Writ that you make known unto our said Justice at the Same day and place aforesaid and have you there and there this writ Writings &c.
