Somerset County Free ling we Comanded you that you attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Henry Fricks Late of Somerset County Esquire if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value of Nine Pounds One Shilling Curr^t money and two hundred twenty eight pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of after said Joseph Venables unless the Said Henry Fricks by himself or attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Joseph Venables in answer of trespass upon the said &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our said County Court to be hold an ass^t to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods or Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seeme mete and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the same day and place ass^t and have you then & there this writt Witness &c
