The said Sum of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco Dugget Coat & pair of Leather Buidles or any part thereof of the same William hath not recovered altho after there unto Requested but the same Thomas the said twelve hundred pounds of tobacco Dugget Coat & pair of Leather Buidles hath taken and delivered to the other Dugget and since doth deny where by the same William saith he is worse & hath damage to the Value of two thousand pounds of tobacco and therefore brings this Suite &c. and brings hereto for the sake of which the Debt doth testify &c.

And the said Thomas Gray by George Dashiell his attorney Counsel and defendeth the force and injury when &c. and prays Leave to Impare hereunto hereunto till the next Court and he hath it & the same day is given to the said Dugget also

At which said Next Court to witt the twenty first day of June and Dowd. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six Cometh again as were the said William Green as the said Thomas Gray by their attorney sds, and thereupon the said Thomas Gray by his said attorney says that he cannot gain say the said his action and against him brought nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory is his act and deed and that the debt therein mentioned is yet due and unsatisfied wherefore the said Dugget prays Judgment for his debt and his Costs and Damages sustained by reason of the Delaying of the same Debt &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the twenty first day of June &c. Year sds that the said William Green recover against the said Thomas Gray as well the Sum of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco Dugget Coat and Leather Buidles his debt and as also the Sum of four hundred and fifty ^{two} pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Damages which he sustained by reason of the Delaying of the same Debt by him about his Suite in that part Expedient to the said Dugget by his sds by the Court here ad judged and the said Dugget in Mercy &c.
