the Court aff before the Justice aff to Enquire for the said Right hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary then & there Impannelled and Charged and Sworn falsely and Maliciously did Exhibit and the aff Tobias altho he well knew all and singular the premises in the said Bill of Indictment contained to be false feigned and contrary to truth then and thereupon his oath falsely maliciously wickedly and Scandalously to the grand Jurors aff did assert and affirm the matter in the said Bill so as aff contained to be true, whereas in truth the matter aff against her the said Sarah in the Bill aff contained above specified was false and contrary to truth and by the aff Tobias falsely wickedly and maliciously devised with intent to molest defame & perjure the said Sarah and after that the aff Tobias had given Evidence as aff upon the bill of Indictment aff to the Grand Jurors, that the aff Grand Jurors then and there to wit at Court aff at dividing Creek aff in the County aff. to the Justice aff gave their answer that they of the matter in the said bill so as aff contained were altogether ignorant by pretext of which prosecution the said Sarah not only in her good Name fame Credit State and Reputation which before was untouched is grievously hurt but also the said Thomas and Sarah divers Sums of money and tobacco in and about the purgation of the said Sarah in the premises aff to expend and Lay out were and are forced and Compelled and in doing Divers their Law full fallings and honest affairs are much hindered and Made worse to their damage of ten thousand pounds of Tobacco and thereupon they bring this Suite

And the said Tobias Burke by George Dashiell his attorney Cometh and depandeth the force and Injury when & and prayeth Leave to Injure hereunto until the Next Court and to hath it and the same day is given to the aff Thomas Holbrook and Sarah his wife also

All which said next Court to wit the Seventeenth day of November and Dond One thousand seven hundred and twenty four came againe as well the aff Thomas Holbrook and Sarah his wife as the aff Tobias Burke by their attorney aff. and thereupon the said Tobias Burke by his said attorney prayed further Leave to Injure hereunto until the Next Court and to hath it and the same day is given to the aff Thomas Holbrook and Sarah his wife also

All which said next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of March and Dond. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four came againe as well the aff Thomas Holbrook and Sarah his wife as the aff Tobias Burke by their attorney aff and the same attorney of the same Tobias, saith that he is not informed by the same Tobias his Flyant, of any answer for the same Tobias to the aff Thomas Holbrook and Sarah his wife in the plea aff to be given, and Nothing Else there of says by that the same Thomas and Sarah Remain against the aff Tobias thereof Undefeuded
