be held and firmly bound unto the aforesaid Robt in his life time in the sum of three thousand
five hundred and Ninety six pounds of tbsd three hundred and thirty two pounds of porke and two
Shillings and Six pence curr: money to be paid the same Robt his Executor or assignee when after
the said Cnic should be dead to pay unto the aforesaid Cnic altho often thereto required
the aforesaid sum of three thousand five hundred and Ninety six pounds of tbsd three hundred and thirty two pounds
of porke and two Shillings and Six pence curr: money to the aforesaid Robt in his life time nor held by any
