

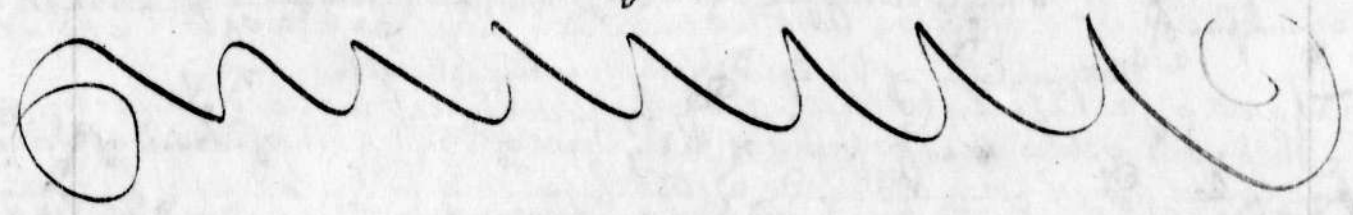
August Court - - - 1726 - - - 158 - -

In and by the Court the above named Thomas Nevett made oath on the Holy Evangelist of almighty god that the above Ad. is Just and true and that he never had any part or parcel thereof as yet 13. 1726

Whereupon the said James English in his proper person Comes and Defend, the force and injury whereof said and says that he cannot gainsay the Debt his action of so as aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that the said Debt ought to recover his damages by reason of the Non performance of the promise and assumption of to five hundred and Sixty three pounds of tolls and Costs of Suite against him - which of said Debt doth not gainsay &

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the Twentieth day of June 1726 and. D. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six that the said Thomas Nevett recover against the said James English as well the Sum of five hundred & Sixty three pounds of tolls his damages as in form of Confessed as also the Sum of three hundred and forty pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in that part Expended to the same Thomas Nevett by the Court here adjudged, with Stay of Execution till the tenth day of November Next and the said Debt in mercy &
