Pet^r for a Commission — To the Worshipfull Justices of Somersett County Cour^t the Petition of
Merrick Ellis of the Said County humbly sheweth —

That your petitioner is possessed of thirty acres of Land part of a tract of Land
called Sot's daughter lying in the County afo^d the bounds whereof are decayed and the Witnesses
to prove them ancient and Infirm, Your Petitioner therefore humbly pray, your worship^s
will I give a Commission to such persons as you shall think proper to examine Evidence
in relation to the boundary thereof according to the form of the act of Assembly in such
case lately made and your pet^r as in Duty bound shall ever pray — Merrick Ellis

The petition afo^d being read and heard and the premises considered, It is thereupon
Ordered by the Court that a Commission I give as by the Pet^r afo^d is pray'd, and that therefor
George Dashwood, Philip Bougton and James Jones of Somersett County Gent^r. be Commissioners
and execute the same Commission as the Law in that Case doth direct &c —
