And the afo^d Mary Eson doth as afo^d by George Darke her attorney Comell and defendant before and Injury when &c and pray leave to Inquer hereunto until the Next Court and she shall it and the same day is given to the afo^d Plaintiff also -

At which said Next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of August anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Six came again as well the afo^d Joseph Mifflin as the afo^d Mary Eson by their attorney afo^d and whereupon the Said Mary by her said attorney say that she cannot gainsay but that the afo^d Benjamin Eson in his life time did promise and upon his self a sum in manner and form as the afo^d Joseph by declaring afo^d above supposed, nor can she say but that the afo^d Joseph ought to recover his damages by occasion of the Non performance of the promise and a sum upon afo^d to four thousand eight hundred and thirty eight pounds of tobacco and cost of suit which the said Eft doth not gainsay &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the same day and year last mentioned that the afo^d Joseph Mifflin recover against the afo^d Mary Eson, being of the afo^d Benjamin Eson as well the sum of four thousand eight hundred and thirty eight pounds of tobacco his damages afo^d in form afo^d confessed as also the sum of three hundred eighty six pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part expended to the same day by the Justices hereof his afo^d adjudged to be devied of the goods and chattels which were the afo^d Benj Eson at the time of his death in the hands of the afo^d Mary Eson as afo^d remaining to be administered if so much
