Charles the fifteenth day of July anno: Domⁱ. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four of Somerset
County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing Obligatory which the same Mary
Sealed with the Seal of the same Charles, hereto Court Brings granted him selfe to be sold and firmly
bound unto the afo^d Robert in his Lifetime in the afo^d sum of two thousand four hundred and Sixty
two pounds of tobo to be paid the same Robert his Executors, ad^d or assign when afterward he
should be thereto required yet the afo^d Charles his selfe often thereto required the afo^d sum of two thou-
sand four hundred and Sixty two pounds of tobo to the same Robert in his Lifetime or the afo^d
Mary since his death hath not tendered but the said Charles the same further to do hath altogether
denied and still doth deny whereby the same Mary says she is worse and hath damage to the
value of three thousand pounds of tobo & whereof she brings this Suit &c and the same Mary brings
hereunto Court the Letters Testementary &c by which &c I have had Read & doth acknowledge

Whereupon the said Charles Young being called appears and whereupon the said Charles Young
at the prayer of the afo^d attorney afo^d is adjudged to give Speciall Bail to the action afo^d

Whereupon afo^d Joseph Bonds and John Cromie both of Somerset County planters
present here in Court underlashed for the said Charles Young that if in Case the said Mary Martin
Shall recover Judgment in the plea afo^d against the said Charles Young or that the said Charles
Young shall be thereupon Convict that then he the said Charles Young shall pay the Condemnation
of the Court here upon or tender his Body to the Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in
Satisfaction thereof that they the said Joseph Bonds & J^r Cromie will do it for him &c

And the said Charles Young in his own proper person comes and defends the same and Injury
