

August Court. 1726. - - - 168

¶ Thomas Dastick command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take William Robinson late of Somerset County Planter if he should be found in his Body with and sume should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of August ^{this next} to answer unto Thomas Dastick of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and that whereof he should not fail.

And the said Thomas Dastick by Levitt Hale his attorney declared against the aforesaid William Robinson in the plea aforesaid followeth vizt —

Somersettp. William Robinson late of Allhallow parish in Somerset County planter was attainted to answer unto Thomas Dastick of a plea of trespass upon the case &c —

And whereupon the same Thomas by Levitt Hale his attorney being sworn that whereas J. W^m Robinson the twentieth day of June one thousand seven hundred & twenty six at the County aforesaid within d^r Jur^d of this Court was indebted unto the said Thomas in summe of one thousand one hundred & seventy seven p^t of sterl^s as by an act herewithin Court produced may appear and so there of being indebted the aforesaid in consideration whereof afterward, to wit the same day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid within the aforesaid d^r Jur^d upon himself affirmed

to the same Thomas knew & there faithfully grounded that he when afterwards he should be thereto required pay the sum of one thousand one hundred and seventy seven p^t of sterl^s to the same Thomas would well & faithfully content & pay never the less J. W^m his promise and assumption aforesaid in form and made little regarding but clothing & fraudulently Intending the same Thomas in that part to defraud & deceiveth him the sum of one thousand one hundred and seventy seven pounds of sterl^s or any part thereof either to, to the same Thomas (altho. often by the same Thomas thereto required afterward, bid the same day & year aforesaid at the County aforesaid within the aforesaid jurisdiction) hath not paid or the J. W^m Thomas for it in any wise contented but the aforesaid the same further to pay, or the same Thomas for it in any wise to content hath altogether refused & still doth refuse whereby the same Thomas saith he is worse & hath damage to the value of two thousand three hundred & fifty four p^t of sterl^s whereof he brings his suit ^{for} ^{of} ^{the} ^{sum} ^{so} ^{damaged}
