 to the same Thomas then & there faithfully promised that he when afterwards he should be
 there to Required by the s^d. sum of one thousand one hundred and seventy seven s^d. of tob^o.
 to the same Thomas would well & faithfully content & pay never the less s^d. W^m. his promise and
 assumption a^d in form a^d made Velle regarding but blotting & fraudulently Intending the same
 Thomas in that part to defraud & deceive the s^d. W^m. the s^d. sum of one thousand one hundred and
 seventy seven pounds of tob^o. or any part thereof either to, to the same Thomas (altho. offer by the
 same Thomas there to required afterwards by the same day & year a^d at the County a^d within
 the s^d. Jurisdiction) hath not paid or the s^d. Thomas for it in any wise contented but the s^d.
 W^m. the same hath to to pay, or the same Thomas for it in any wise to content hath altogether
 refused & still doth refuse whereby the same Thomas say he is worse & hath damage to
 the value of two thousand three hundred & fifty four s^d. of tob^o. & hereof he brings this Suite &c.
