Thereupon Command is given to the Sherif of Somerset County that immediately he cause to come here twelve etc. by whom etc. who neither etc. to be cogniz'd etc. because as well etc. of which said precept the said Sherif to wit Francis Abbot Gent. Now hereat this day to wit the same day and year last mentioned makes return that he hath here ready twelve etc. as by his said Precept he was commanded and now hereafterwards to wit the same day and year comes as well the said etc. as the said etc. by their attorneys etc. and the Jurors of that Jury herein Impannelled being called Likewise came to wit, Robert Miles, Henry Alexander, Thomas Sayfield, William Saper, Benjⁿ. Hook, Thomas Culbert, John Fleming, Thomas Nathaniel Williams, Thomas Beavis, Cannon Winwright, Alexander Carlyle, Isaac Brickingham who being duly Elected tryed and sworn upon their Oath to say that the said James Steele is guilty of the premises as the said Donuok above against him hath declared; and do assess the Damages of the same Donuok besides his Costs and Charges in this behalf Said Out and Expended to four pounds ten Shillings Current money and for those Costs and Charges to one pound of t^o -

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice here the Sixteenth day of August and Doin. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six that the said Donuok Dennis recover against the said James Steele as well the Sum of four pounds ten Shillings Current money and one pound of t^o his damages etc. by the Jurors etc. assessed as also the Sum of Eight hundred and Eighty Eight pounds of t^o for his Costs and Charges by him about his Side in that part Expended to the same Donuok by the Court here of Increase ad judged which certain Damages in the whole do amount to four pounds ten Shillings and Eight hundred and Eighty Nine pounds of t^o and the said Debt in money etc.
