Donwick besides his Costs and Charges in this behalf laid Out and Expended to four pounds
ten Shillings current money and for more Costs and Charges to one pound of toto —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the Sixteenth day of August.
and Dated One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Six that the afo^d Donwick Dennis recover against
the afo^d James Steele as well the sum of four pounds ten Shillings curr^t money and one pound
of toto his damages afo^d by the Juror afo^d assessed as also the sum of Eight hundred and Eighty
Eight pounds of toto for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part Expended to the
same Donwick by the Court here of Increase adjudged which certain Damages in the whole do amount
to four pounds ten Shillings and Eight hundred and Eighty Nine pounds of toto and the afo^d Defd in
