The afo^d William hath sustaine^d as by Occasion of the Non performance of the promise and
assumption afo^d as for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in that part ~~sustained~~
and the Inquisition which thereof he should take to his Lordshys Justice at Dividing Creek
the third Tuesday of March next under his Seal and the Seals of those by whose Oath he make

And whereupon the afo^d William Comis by his attorney afo^d, prays the Court that the
will of Inquire of Damages afo^d, on which the Inquisition above is returned may be quashed
for that the return day thereon mentioned, is said, to be the third Tuesday of March when

Therefore it is Considered by the Justice ^{here} that the afo^d William Comis take nothing by
his will and Inquisition afo^d, but that the same will and Inquisition be quashed above
and held for Nothing &c

cause to be paid unto the above Edward and Grafton Rackliff their heire^s & d^r adit or
