Adam an negro boy belonging to Leg^t John Donelson is adjudged by the Court to be of the age of three years this term &c

Hannah an negro girl of Leg^t John Donelson is adjudged by the Court to be of the age of two years this term &c

Roger Anderson an servant boy belonging to Leg^t James Lindon Imported into this Country in the Sloop called John of Dublin is adjudged to be of the age of twelve years this term &c

To the Worshipful Justice of Somerset County now in Court sitting - the humble Petⁿ of William Fox ^{Bel^l} for Negro to be free } William Fox humbly sheweth - that your petitioner hath an old negro woman which is part her Labour your petitioner therefore humbly prays that your worship will grant such Order as in your wisdom shall think fit that your petitioner may be discharged from hereafter paying taxes for the said Negro woman and your petitioner shall or in duty bound ever pray &c
The petition of being read and heard and Maturnally considered - It is therefore Ordered by the Court that the said William Fox be discharged for the future, from paying taxes for the said Negro woman as by the petition of is prayd &c

To the worshipful Justice of Somerset County Court the petition of James Green ^{Bel^l ag^t} } humbly sheweth - that your Petitioner is detained as a servant by Nohomiah - Nohomiah Nicholson, altho' the said Nohomiah hath no Indenture, or any thing else sufficient to hold him your Petitioner therefore humbly prays your Worship (the premises considered) to grant him such relief as is agreeable to Equity and Justice and your petitioner shall ever pray &c
